1. Purpose

3. Roles and Responsibilities

3.1 Responsibilities of the Company

- Conduct interviews and select suitable candidates.
- Provide structured training, mentoring, and exposure to real-time projects.
- Pay a minimum stipend and travel allowance.
- Ensure students gain industry-relevant skills in embedded systems.
- Offer placement opportunities to deserving candidates, with possible client-site deployment.
- Protect and manage intellectual property rights.

3.2 Responsibilities of the Institution

- Nominate eligible students with interest in embedded systems.
- Permit students to participate full-time for at least 4 months.
- Recognize partial project submissions for academic credit.
- Facilitate coordination between students and the Company.

4. Intellectual Property & Confidentiality

- All work, designs, code, and project outcomes developed during the program shall remain the **exclusive property of the Company.**
- Students may present **non-confidential portions** of their work for academic submission, only with prior Company approval.
- Both parties agree to maintain confidentiality of proprietary information.

5. Duration

This MoU shall remain valid for a period of **24months** from the date of signing, unless terminated earlier by mutual consent.

6. Termination


Either party may terminate this MoU by giving **30days' written notice**, subject to settlement of ongoing commitments.

The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.

PURPOSE: This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is made and entered into by and between **STRYDO TECHNOLOGIES PVT LTD** and **GLOBAL INSTITUTE OF ENGINEERING AND TECHNOLOGY**. The purpose of this MOU is to establish a collaborative partnership between the two parties to provide training and project support to students, enhancing their skills and preparing them for future careers in the IT industry.

1. The projects will be designed to address current industry challenges, giving students exposure to practical problem-solving and innovation.

3. Resource Sharing: Both companies will share resources, including training materials, software tools, and technical expertise, to enhance the effectiveness of the training programs and project work.

STRYDO TECHNOLOGIES PVT LTD and **GLOBAL INSTITUTE OF ENGINEERING AND TECHNOLOGY** will collaborate on the development of curriculum, project plans, and assessment methods.

4. Mentorship and Guidance: Experienced professionals from **STRYDO TECHNOLOGIES PVT LTD** and **GLOBAL INSTITUTE OF ENGINEERING AND TECHNOLOGY** will serve as mentors to students, providing guidance, feedback, and support throughout the training and project phases.

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

CLAUSE 1 CO-OPERATION

- 1.2 The general terms for co-operation shall be represented by this MOU. CLAUSE 2 SCOPE OF THE MoU

- 2.4 **Curriculum Design:** Second Party can give valuable inputs to the First Party, suitably customize the curriculum and in project training methodology, so that the students fit into the industrial scenario meaningfully.

- 2.11 Financial considerations can be decided at the time of issuing work orders.

**CLAUSE 3
INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY**

- 3.1 Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppel or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

**CLAUSE 4
VALIDITY**

- 4.1 This Agreement will be valid until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms, during which period **Training Partner** or **Strydo Group of Companies**, as the case may be, will take effective steps for implementation of this MOU. Any act on the part of **Training Partner**, or **Strydo Group of Companies**, after termination of this Agreement by way of communication, correspondence etc., shall not be construed as an extension of this MOU.
- 4.2 Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination both parties have to discharge their obligations.

**CLAUSE 5
RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES**

- 5.1 It is expressly agreed that **STRYDO TECHNOLOGIES PVT LTD** and **GLOBAL INSTITUTE OF ENGINEERING AND TECHNOLOGY** are acting under this MOU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Party is neither authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations nor create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party.

Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.

5. Monitor the program by conducting regular assessments to ensure that the trainers maintain a high standard of quality.



DURATION OF MOU

Suhas Swaroop (Managing Director), which expression shall unless repugnant to the context and meaning thereof include its successors, administrators and permitted assignees).

Hereinafter individually referred to as CII or GLOBAL INSTITUTE OF ENGINEERING AND TECHNOLOGY, as it may be, and collectively referred to as the parties.

WHEREAS:

CII is a non-government, non-profit, industry led and industry managed organization, which works to create and an environment conducive to the growth of industries in India through advisory and consultative process CII charts change by working closely with Government on policy issues, interfacing with thought leaders, and enhancing efficiency, competitiveness and business opportunities through a range of specialized services and strategic global linkages. NOW THEREFORE, BOTH THE PARTIES HEREBY AGREE AS UNDER

ARTICLE I: Purpose and Objectives

Both the Parties, by way of this MOU express their commitment to collaborate with each other to:

- 1) The role of the institution would be to enroll All students or minimum of 250 students at the beginning of the year and increase the same substantially through the years.
- 2) Yi and Education Partner shall motivate and provide opportunities to the students to engage in activities and initiatives that they conceptualize, create reports regularly on their activities to the Yi Executive Member and participate in the Yi National & Chapter events in other cities like the summit (finer details to be worked in coherence with the Institution's policies)
- 3) Both the parties are desirous of promoting mutual cooperation and wish to expand the basis for friendly and cooperative educational and academic collaborations by way of this MOU.
- 4) Both the Parties understand and acknowledge that this MOU is a pre-requisite for further collaboration and cooperation activities, academic partnerships etc.
- 5) Any other activities considered by both parties to be potentially beneficial.

ARTICLE II: Financials

Unless otherwise specifically agreed to in writing by the Parties, each Party will bear on their own the respective costs of carrying out the obligations under the MOU. Each party is responsible for its own taxes and compliances in respect to the deliverables envisaged herein and shall not hold the other party responsible for such taxes and compliances, This is merely a broad understanding between the parties in furtherance to the common intention for accomplishing the objectives mentioned herein above. In future, if the parties intend to enter into any financial arrangement, the legal rights and commercial obligations of the parties as applicable shall be delineated through separate documents on case to case basis. Taxes if any will be charged extra and withholding tax if any will be deducted by respective party on any financial transaction as per applicable laws.

ARTICLE III: Coordination between Facilitators

Both the Parties shall nominate one or more senior representative/officer, who shall be the point of contact/facilitator for the purposes of this MOU. The facilitators of both the parties shall maintain regular contact with the other party as well as propose and review different academic projects, programs and other activities in furtherance of objectives of the purpose and objectives envisioned under this MOU. The Facilitators may also be required to report to and coordinate with different committees or boards for the purposes of this MOU, as may be necessary.

ARTICLE IV: Intellectual Property Rights

both the Parties shall:

- i) Share with each other all data, research and findings relating to activities, projects undertaken under this MOU.
- ii) Enjoy joint ownership of all intellectual property rights in terms of copyrights, patents, trademarks for any discoveries, inventions researches and any outcomes resulting from joint activities undertaken under this MOU.

ARTICLE V: Confidentiality

For the purpose of this MOU:

CLAUSE 4– VALIDITY

- 4.1 This Agreement is established in the English Language and is valid from the date of signing by the representatives of both parties. Both parties here to have executed this Agreement in duplicate, and each party shall keep one copy of the originals.
- 4.2 This agreement shall be valid for a period of one year from the date both signatures are affixed to this document or before if terminated by mutual agreement of both parties.
- 4.3 Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon **30 calendar days'** notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both the parties will be discharged from their respective obligations.
- 4.4 If a proposal to renew this agreement is not presented before the end validity period, it will be terminated automatically at the end of one years
- 4.5 This agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of India.
- 4.6 The two parties will consult each other and attempt to resolve disputes or misunderstandings that arise in the administration of this agreement informally.
- 4.7 The implementation of specific activities will be separately agreed between both institutions on a need basis.
- 4.8 Other terms and conditions which are not provided in this agreement will be deliberated and agreed upon by the institutions here to.

CLAUSE 5 - RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

5.1 It is expressly agreed that **GIT** and **UPDATER SERVICES LTD** are acting under this MOU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any Kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.






